

# ACART- LARGE ANIMAL EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS CHECKLIST



The following is a checklist of items to have ready in case of an evacuation and an emergency. ACART recommends you have an area near your livestock or in your barn marked *'in case of an emergency'*. This bin or bucket should contain items and information that could assist you or a rescuer helping to evacuate your animals to a safe location.

- List of Animals on your property** (*and location if applicable*) in the event you are not home during an evacuation.
- Animal Information:** posted in barn/near animals: with animal name, color markings, health conditions and medications (*in the case of an evacuation when you are not at home*).
- Owner Information:** your name, phone number and email.  
**Other Emergency Contact Information:** name, phone number and email.
- Veterinary Information:** name, phone number and email.  
Animal vaccinations and health records.
- Large Animal Supplies:** leather or cotton halters, lead ropes, fly mask, blankets, buckets.
- Feed and Water:** enough for 3-7 days for each animal.
- Medications/Prescriptions:** instructions for administration, other supplements.
- Farrier Information:** name, phone number and email.
- Other Helpful Supplies:** large animal first aid kit, large scissors, wire cutters, duct tape, marking pen, pocketknife, zip-ties, cotton bandana, leather gloves, flashlight and batteries.
