ACART- SMALL ANIMAL EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS CHECKLIST



ACART recommends you have these items available and labeled 'in case of an emergency' and placed near your family's other emergency supplies. The container should contain items and information that could assist you or a rescuer in helping to evacuate your animals to a safe location.

List of Animals on your property (and location if applicable) in the event you are not home during an evacuation.
Animal Information: placed in your emergency supply container: with animal type (e.g., 2 dogs, 1cat), names, color markings, health conditions and medications (in the case of an evacuation when you are not at home).
Owner Information: your name, phone number and email.
Other Emergency Contact information: name, phone number and email.
Veterinary Information: name, phone number and email. Animal vaccinations and health records.
Small Animal Supplies: collars, leashes, harnesses, muzzles, bowls, blankets/bedding, stakes/tie outs, pillowcase (feline), and pet carriers labeled with your name. Covers for bird or small animal cages/crates.
Feed and Water: enough for 3-7 days for each animal.
Medications/Prescriptions: instructions for administration, other supplements.
Other Helpful Supplies: small animal first aid kit, scissors, wire cutters, duct tape, marking pen, pocketknife, cotton bandana, leather gloves, flashlight, and batteries.
